She earned her M.F.A in Dance from the University of Washington and her B.A. in Dance from the University of Texas. She is also the co-editor of a groundbreaking anthology on site-specific dance, *Site Dance: Choreographers and the Lure of Alternative Spaces* that is scheduled for publication in 2009.
