Summary

Criteria

- Must be a freshman, sophomore or junior enrolled in a dance program at a private or MDC-member high school, company or private studio
- 3.0 or above grade point average
- Current Michigan Dance Council student member

Requirements

- Proof of MDC student membership or membership application and fee, if not already a student member
- Letter of recommendation from current dance teacher (250 words).
- Completed application form
- Statement of need (200 words). Expresses how receiving this award will help you. This could be financially, artistically, or any other way that receiving the Zirulnik Scholarship will help you.
- Statement of proposed study (150 words). The Zirulnik Scholarship may not be used for competitions, competition camps or regularly scheduled studio classes.
- Description of how dance impacts your life (150 words). What does dance mean to you?
- Proof of GPA
- Award recipients are required to submit an essay about their summer experience for inclusion in the fall edition of MDC newsletter with photo to the address below. **Deadline: August 20, 2019**
